Download Reviver App

Download the Reviver app at the Apple App Store for you iPhone or the Google Play Store for your Android

Create Your Account

Create your Reviver account in the mobile app.

Add Vehicle

Tap the + icon to proceed





Add Your RPLATE To Your Account

Scan the serial number on the front top right corner of your plate and enter the email used when purchasing your RPLATE.

Set Up Your RPLATE

Follow the in-app instructions to setup your RPLATE and add your vehicle registration to the device. You will need to submit photos of your latest vehicle registration document and your license plate.

RPLATE Installation

Once our team has confirmed your vehicle and plate info, you will receive a notification by email and through your Reviver app to refresh your RPLATE and display your license plate image.




⚠ Is Your RPLATE showing a "Detached" Message?

Make sure that it is in contact with the included metal bracket that you will attach to the rear of your car shortly. The RPLATE has an anti-theft sensor - attaching it to the bracket will allow you to complete step 6.



- · Glass cleaner



Remove Plate

Remove existing plate and all components, including any adhesive foam or tape.

Clean Surface

Clean surface with alcohol wipe provided.

On vehicles with special coating (ceramic, wrap and matte finish), use microfiber towel and glass cleaner.


If your license plate is mounted to your vehicle with two screws,

GO TO STEP 8







Use suppled screws only (Bag A)

Selecting Screws

Choose the correct new screws by comparing the old and new screw diameter




Break off this direction

Snap Off Lower Screw Mounts

Take the included bracket and snap off lower screw mounts. Bend the lower two tabs 90 degrees towards the side of the bracket with writing on the stickers, then return to original position and repeat until they break free.




Mount the RPLATE Bracket

Mount the RPLATE bracket with the correct screws. Make sure holes are aligned properly.

In the set of 3 vertical holes at the top, start by trying to mount the bracket using the middle holes as shown in the image. If you need to adjust the bracket up or down based on space available in your license plate area, use the holes immediately above or below.



Test Fit the RPLATE


Make sure RPLATE bracket tape is flush to vehicle so that the adhesive strip will attach properly. If necessary for a better fit, adjust the bracket up or down as mentioned in step 5.




Cut Off Flaps

Snip off the bottom of the red cover flaps so that it won't be visible below the plate. Leave the cover flaps on the adhesive behind the plate.



Mount the RPLATE bracket with the correct screws. Make sure holes are aligned properly.

In the set of 3 vertical holes at the top, start by trying to mount the bracket using the middle holes as shown in the image. If you need to adjust the bracket up or down, based on space available in your license plate area, use the holes immediately above or below.









Test fit the RPLATE

Make sure the RPLATE fits well within the license plate mounting area on your vehicle. If necessary, adjust the bracket up or down as mentioned in step 10.






Reinstall the RPLATE
